



## ICSM Colours Policy

Last Updated: February 2014

### Criteria

The below prizes are designed to give thanks and recognition to individuals who have given years of dedicated service to the Union and to the life of the Medical School. Honorary awards may be given to exceptional individuals who are not registered members of the Union. **They are generally, but not exclusively, reserved for final year students.**

- **ICSM Colours** are awarded to individuals highly involved in clubs and societies, the Students' Union, academic and pastoral representation, who are **well rounded** and who repeatedly turn up and support the work of others.
- **ICSM Outstanding Service Awards** are awarded to individuals who have, in addition to the requirements for Colours, repeatedly gone above and beyond their role to enhance the life of ICSM.
- **ICSM Fellowships** are awarded to individuals who have continuously served the Students' Union and enhanced the student experience in an exceptional manner over a number of years. Typically few (if any) of these are awarded every year.
- **The Sir Roger Bannister Prize** is awarded to individuals who have represented us national or has excelled exceptionally in a range of sports during their time at ICSM.

### Awards

The awards should be presented at the ICSM Summer Ball:

- **ICSM Colours** holders will be given a certificate, signed by the ICMSU President and a senior member of the Faculty of Medicine, and a free ICSM Colours Tie or Scarf.
- **Sir Roger Bannister Prize** winners will be given a certificate, signed by the ICMSU President and a senior member of the Faculty of Medicine, a free ICSM Colours Tie or Scarf, and a mantelpiece.
- **ICSM Outstanding Service Award** holders will be given a certificate, signed by the ICMSU President and a senior member of the Faculty of Medicine, a free ICSM Colours Tie or Scarf, and a tankard.

- **ICSM Fellowship** holders will be given a certificate, signed by the ICSMSU President and a senior member of the Faculty of Medicine, a free ICSM Colours Tie or Scarf, and a mantelpiece.
  - If they become members of the ICSM Alumni Association, they are entitled to complimentary tickets to ICSMSU events. They will be expected, but not required, to make a donation to the event. They will be required to give at least two weeks' notice to the event organiser if they intend to take advantage of this privilege. If the event is likely to sell out, the event organiser has the right to charge them the student price.
  - These events include:
    - Freshers' Fortnight & Freshers' Ball
    - RAG Week
    - Bops at the Reynolds Bar
    - Comedy, Jazz, Quiz, Bands Nights at the Reynolds Bar
    - The Snow Ball
    - The Valentines Ball
    - The Shrove Tuesday Final Year Dinner After-party
    - The Summer Ball After-party
  - They are eligible to pay student prices for the following events:
    - The Arts or Sports Dinner
    - The Summer Ball Dinner
    - Shrove Tuesday Final Year Dinner

## Choosing the Winners

Only School of Medicine students can nominate individuals to win these awards. Any student within the School of Medicine may nominate and be nominated for an award:

- Nominations should be open for at least 2 weeks (normally longer).
- Nominations should be made in writing to the ICSMSU President or their nominee.
- Students may not nominate themselves.

Once the nomination period has closed, the Colours Committee should convene within a few weeks before the awards are given out. The Colours Committee should consist of:

- The ICSMSU President
- The ICSMSU President-elect
- At least 3 members of the ICSMSU Executive Committee
- At least 2 members of staff within the Faculty of Medicine
- At least 1 member of the ICSM Alumni Association Executive Committee

The decision of the Colours Committee is final. The colours committee may choose the number of awards which are given out and to whom they are given. Not all the awards need to be given out every year.

## Affiliated Prizes

### ICSM Alumni Prize

The **ICSM Alumni Prize** is a separate prize, which has been created with the intention of highly commending a member of the medical school whilst increasing the awareness of ICSM Alumni to past and present students. The prize should be an award that recognises the impact an individual has had in **increasing the positive awareness of ICSM beyond the ICSM community**. The criteria for those nominated should illustrate:

- Participation in local, national or international bodies. These may include activities that are: political, social, medical, educational, or contributing to the arts.
- Dedication to voluntary or community based projects undertaken as an ICSM representative, which draw positive attention to the medical school.
- To be given to an individual who may not necessarily have been prominent within the medical school but who has nevertheless contributed greatly to positive awareness of ICSM.

The Colours Committee will provide recommendations for this prize to the Executive Committee of the ICSM Alumni Association.

The **ICSM Alumni Prize** will also be presented at the ICSM Summer Ball and winners will be given a certificate, signed by the ICSMSU President and a senior member of the Faculty of Medicine, and a gift from the ICSM Alumni Association.

### Dr Stephen Norton Memorial Prize

The **Stephen Norton Memorial Prize** is an external award that commemorates the life of Dr Stephen Norton, who was a student, houseman and S.H.O at Charing Cross from 1966 to 1973. Stephen died in January 2008 and the prize has been awarded ever since then.

The fund donates £500 per annum to the medical school's hardship fund, to which Stephen already contributed and £500 per annum to a deserving final year student who most exemplifies Stephen's all-round qualities. This fund is made possible by the generosity of Stephen's friends and colleagues in recognition of an all-rounded student.

The Colours Committee will provide recommendations (with their attached nominations) for this prize to the Trustees of the Stephen Norton Memorial Fund, who will make the final decision on a deserving winner.

The **Dr Stephen Norton Memorial Prize** winner will normally be presented at the annual ICSM Affirmation Ceremony by one of the fund's trustees.
